#### **Directions**

When we travel, it is possible that we can be lost and we don't know where the places are. It is also possible that we meet someone who is travelling and asking for directions. Here are some expressions we can use when asking and giving directions.

#### **Asking for Directions**

To ask for directions, remember to always be polite. Here are some expressions to show our politeness:

- Hello. Could you help me?
- Good morning. May I ask for some help?
- Excuse me, could you help?

After we get someone's attention, we may ask them to show us the direction of the place:

- Could you tell me how to get to the bank?
- Do you know where the museum is?
- We can't find the bus station. Is it near here?
- Where can we find a park near here?






If you're not sure you're going in the right direction, you can make sure by asking:

- Are we on the right road to the city center?
- Is this the right way to the mall?
- What's the best way to get to the airport?

## **Giving Directions**



Here are some expressions we can use to give directions:


- Go past the cinema
- Go along this road (go through)
- Go straight on/ahead (stay on this road don't turn)
- Go through the tunnel.
- At the roundabout, take the first exit.
- Turn left at the crossroads.
- Take the second right.
- It's on your left.
- You'll see it in front of you.
- It's on the other side of the road.
- You're going the wrong way.
