Small talk? Is it a talk about something little? Miniature? Unfortunately, that's not what small talk means. Small talk is a light or casual conversation that you can talk about after introducing yourself. How to begin a small talk?

### **Topic for Small Talk**

So, what topic should you talk about? Here are some general things that you can discuss with your new foreign friends:

- Weather
- Sports
- Food
- Travel

- Hometown
- Hobbies
- Entertainment

Also, it's very important to remember that **YOU SHOULD NOT** talk about these things:

- Politics
- Religions
- Age

It is considered to be **impolite** and **rude** when we ask our new friends the topics

- Financial
- Appearance
- Offensive jokes above, because those things are their privacy.





# **Useful phrases for Small Talk**

#### Weather

Beautiful day, isn't it?
Yes, it's very nice today!

It's warm/chilly/cold, right?
Yes, it's a bit warm here

Do you like the weather here?
I like it here/I prefer my country

How is the weather in your country?
It's always cold/warm there

#### **Travel**

Do you travel a lot?
Yes, I do

• Is this your first time here? - Yes, it's my first time here

What's your favorite country/city?
My favorite city is Yogyakarta

What do you think about Indonesia?
I love Indonesia. It's beautiful!

#### **Food**

• Do you like Indonesian food?

What food do you like?

Which Indonesian food do you like?

#### **Entertainment**

What is your favorite movie/book/song?

Do you like to watch movie/listen to music/read books?

Who is your favorite actor/singer?





### **Example A**

- A: Good morning and welcome aboard! My name is Niko and I will be your guide today.
- B: Morning, Niko! I'm Joanna, I'm happy to join you.
- A: Hi Joanna, nice to meet you. Where are you from?
- B: I'm from Amsterdam, Netherlands.
- A: Oh, you're Dutch! How do you like the weather here in Bandung?
- B: The weather here is very nice. It's chilly. Are you from Bandung?
- A: I'm from Jakarta, but I live in Bandung.
- B: Oh, how is the weather in Jakarta?
- A: Well, it is warmer than Bandung.

# **Example B**

- A: Hi, my name is Martin. Nice to meet you!
- B: Nice to meet you too, I'm Rika. Where are you from Martin?
- A: I'm from Lisbon, Portugal. What about you?
- B: Ah, you're Portuguese. I'm from Indonesia and I live in Jakarta.
- A: Oh Jakarta, I love it! I went there last year
- B: Do you like to travel?
- A: Yes, I do. I like to go to new places.
